Later attorney David Singleton addressed the full audience in the primary conference room. Using the theory of interest convergence, first used in connection with racial civil rights issues, he spoke eloquently about the value of utilizing this theory in our civil rights issue, that of

restoring the full rights of citizenship to persons required to register on sexual offense registries. His message was followed by a lively question and answer session.
