Organization works to restore constitutional rights

Raleigh, North Carolina | September 20, 2021 -- The National Association for Rational Sexual Offense Laws (NARSOL) will convene October 8-10 in Houston, Texas for a program of presentations and workshops from attorneys, researchers, activists, and other notable people in the field of criminal justice reform.

NARSOL is the nation's oldest and largest civil rights organization exclusively dedicated to defending the constitutional liberties of registered citizens and their families. NARSOL opposes dehumanizing registries and works to eliminate discrimination, banishment, and vigilantism against persons accused or convicted of sexual offenses through the use of impact litigation, public education, legislative advocacy, and media outreach in order to reintegrate and reconcile affected individuals and restore their constitutional rights. At their yearly conference, NARSOL trains advocates in legislative advocacy, media outreach, and how to educate the public. The conferences typically include presentations by one or more dedicated attorneys to keep attendees abreast of current litigation that impacts people who are required to register.
